Location: Palacio de la Magdalena

The location for the first day will be city's most emblematic building: the **Palacio de la Magdalena**.

Built in the early years of the XX century, was used first as a **summer residence for the Spanish Kings**.

After 1931, the Palace has served as hospital and as a temporary residence for the affected citizens by the city's fire in 1941.

Nowadays, during the summer, hosts summer courses as headquarters of the **International University of Melendez Pelayo**.

The rest of the year its rooms harbor different congresses and meetings. Outstanding examples are the European Union foreign affairs ministries working sessions of 1995, the **British-Spanish "Tertulias"** (1996), the **French-Spanish summit of 1999** and the **European Union summit of Tourism Ministries in 2002**.

Íñigo Losada Rodríguez is an Hydraulic Engineering Professor in the University of Cantabria. He is the Director of the Hydraulic Institute (**IH Cantabria**).

He has worked for institutions such as the **World Bank**, **CEPAL-ONU**, **UNDP** and the **Interamerican Bank for development**, among many other outstanding institutions. He has recently been awarded with the **Jaime I award**, and has been named Academic in the **Royal Academy of Engineering**.

Today he will talk about his membership in the IPCC (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change), the United Nations body for assessing

the science related to climate change, in which he is Coordinating Lead Author of the 5th Report on Climate Change.

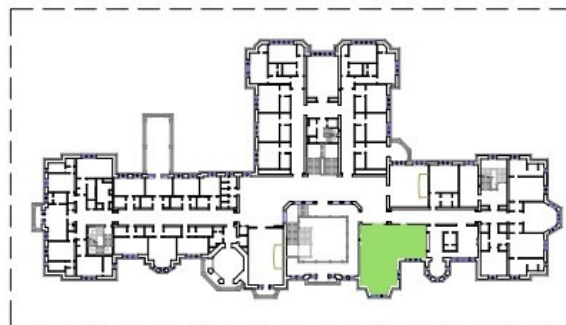

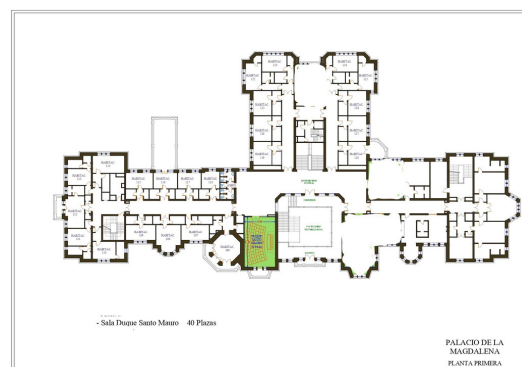

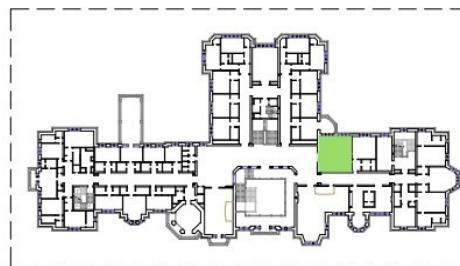
